



COVID19 – CURRENT CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

We are excited to be reopening from Monday, 11th October 2021 and welcoming you back with socially distant open arms.

In reopening, we must adhere to the NSW Government mandated health measures. This will mean entering our premises will be a little different, to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all.

CHECK IN VIA THE QR CODE on your smartphone. You'll see QR codes on entry. If you do not have a smartphone, ask one of our volunteers to help check you in, they'll be more than happy to assist.

SHOW PROOF OF YOUR VACCINATED STATUS when you arrive.

As Government-required, this must be one of the following documents:

- COVID-19 digital certificate or immunisation history statement either printed or on a smartphone (accessed through Express Plus Medicare mobile app or Medicare Online Account)
- COVID-19 digital certificate incorporated into the Service NSW App
- Medical Exemption shown on your immunisation history or Medical Clearance Certificate

If you have experienced cold or flu like symptoms in the last 14 days, have a temperature and/or been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or waiting on results from a COVID-19 test, it is our right to refuse you entry into our venue. The health and safety of our patrons and volunteers is extremely important to us.

Please contact us before your event if any of the above applies to you.

Visitors are not permitted to enter the building if you:

- are experiencing any flu-like symptoms (sore throat, runny nose, persistent cough, shortness of breath, fever);
- have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 (during the period of time in which the virus is contagious);
- are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19;
- reside with anyone who is awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19;
- returned from international travel and failed to observe the government requirement to quarantine

Visitors are required to:

- Maintain social distancing at all times
- Wear face masks unless eating or drinking
- Respect floor markings and directional signage
- Remain in allocated seats
- Leave furniture in place
- Avoid prolonged gatherings
- Register your attendance using the displayed NSW Government QR code and register as required to enable contact tracing
- Show proof of your vaccination status
- Maintain good personal hand hygiene by washing hands and sanitising
- Maintain good respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into your elbow or a tissue, and then dispose of tissues immediately
